AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

1. To achieve the advancement of the social, cultural, welfare, recreational, leisure and educational interest of the Tamil Community in Queensland.
2. To promote friendly relations and to foster cultural relations with Tamil people living in other states and countries.
3. To assist special category of Tamil migrants (eg. Aged, Students, and financially distressed)
4. To coordinate efforts in Queensland to provide immediate humanitarian relief to Tamil people at risk.
5. To raise funds to uplift the life standards of Tamil people in need.
6. To assist in providing food, clothing, shelter, medical assistance and nursing for the Tamil people in need.
7. To promote and conduct research into medical, nutritional, agricultural and other economic and social matters related to the relief of poverty, distress and sufferings of Tamil people in general.
8. To contribute to the establishment or maintenance of any charitable schools, technical or otherwise for the training or education of Tamil people in general.
9. To organize, present and conduct lectures, conferences, debates, courses, training, exhibitions and to produce edit publish and distribute periodicals, pamphlets and other publications that are beneficial to Tamil people in need.
10. To establish and support to aid in the establishment and support to any charitable associations, societies, institutions, trust funds established or about to be established in any part of the world, for any charitable purpose to benefit the needy Tamil people directly or indirectly.
11. To Co-operate and assist projects, undertake investment program to support welfare projects.
12. To promote and participate in multi-cultural activities in Queensland.
